Refer to the below table to help explain what units are required each semester throughout your course. The units in your planner are colour coded to assist you with mapping out your studies.

Bachelor of Design (Interior Architecture) Honours

Course 400 Credit Points

Core units 100 Credit points

A set of compulsory units you must complete as part of your Course.

Interior Architecture Major 100 Credit points

A structured set of 8 units or 100 credit points in a field of study specific to your course.

Component Units 100 credit points

Can be completed as a **CO-MAJOR**

A structured set of 8 units or 100 credit points in a field of study outside your course area which you can choose in addition to a first major.

OR

A combination of the following: MINOR

A structured set of 4 units or 50 credit points from a field of study which you can choose in addition to a first major.

ELECTIVES Stand alone units from any study area.
